Re: Preparing for the Fall meeting of the Summit

The purpose of this letter is to invite you to attend the second meeting of the Forestry TruckSafe Summit, to be held October 27th and 28th in Vancouver. The location will be communicated to you shortly.

Building on our first meeting in Prince George and the work that will be completed prior to the fall meeting, we expect to be in a position to agree on the key elements of a long-term plan of action that will deal with the many areas and issues identified in Prince George. The purpose of the Fall meeting, therefore, is to finalize the Forestry TruckSafe Action Plan.
