



**New Entrant  
Endorsement of Safety  
Program and Commitment  
to SAFE Certification**

Updated July 23, 2010

An *Endorsement of Safety Program and Commitment to SAFE Certification* is awarded to **new entrants** into the BC forest sector who have demonstrated, through a documentation review, they have a health and safety management system that meets a minimum standard of the SAFE Companies audit standard.

A new entrant may include:

- A new business entity in the last 90 days;
- An inactive company;
- An existing business expanding into forest sector activities;
- An out of province business;
- Others circumstances that are acceptable to the Council.

An endorsement enables new entrants to the forest sector to be eligible to bid on contracts with an organization that require SAFE certification as a pre-requisite to bid on work.

Endorsement will be time limited to a maximum 6 months and length of endorsement will be dependent on their certification timeline commitment as outlined in their application. Endorsement will only be granted once
