

Members' Rights and Access to Information Under the Society Act

Under the Societies Act members have the right to access the following information:

1. Financial Statements

Audited Financial Statements including (if applicable)

- Statement of income and expenditure
- Statement of surplus
- Statement of source and application of funds
- Balance sheet

Copy of the Auditors Report

Statement of Director's Remuneration

Prior to the AGM a member of the Society may by giving 5 days notice, request that the auditor is in attendance at the AGM.

2. Examination of Documents and Records

General documents, including financial records of a society, may be examined by members and directors during normal business hours (with reasonable notice) by calling the BCFSC office at 250-741-1060 or toll free at 1-877-741-1060. Documents containing private information protected under federal privacy laws (i.e. personal information such as personnel records and BCFSC Members documents containing confidential contractual information) are excluded.
