 - i. Safety Report (indicating contractor and truck #)

 - 4. Seat belt use
 - ii. Overall report lists contractors in a chart indicating top and bottom performers based on above criteria.
 - iii. Cycle Times Report (based on established Geofences)
 - b. Reports will indicate positive and negative behaviour, allow tracking of safety performance and be utilized to drive punitive measures or incentives around behaviour.
 - c. Reports would indicate cycle times, which would be used as a tool in the development of sector times and rate development and negotiation.
