

FACE SHIELDS

SAFE HYGIENE PRACTICES

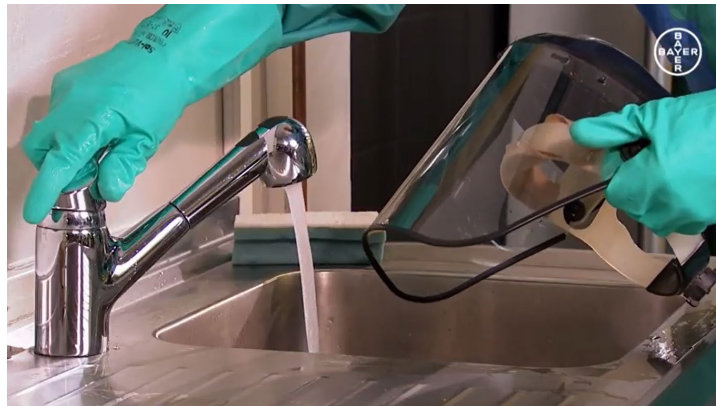
Face shields help create a barrier between employees when physical distancing is not possible. However, **social distancing and good hygiene is still the primary line of defense.**

Considerations:

- Supply may be limited.
- Employees who have more one-on-one interactions with co-workers will likely get priority for face shield distribution.
- At least one person working together in a pair should be wearing a face shield on-site.
- Face shields may also be used for other workplace activities (grinding, etc.) and should be appropriately rated for the task at hand.



Face Shield Hygiene



1. Rinse your shield.
2. Spray shield with bleach water solution, use alcohol wipe or other cleaning solution.
3. Wipe shield down.
4. Wash again to ensure there is no lingering chemicals.
5. Frequency of washing depends on use, but it is recommended to be daily.
