# **Risk Matrix**

### **Required Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):**

- Face mask(s)
- Medical or food safe gloves
- Safety glasses
- Disinfectant wipes or hand sanitizer

- Soap and jug of water
- Garbage bag
- Paper towel (blue shop towel can also be used for improvised face mask if needed)
- Bag to place used non-disposable masks in prior to cleaning
