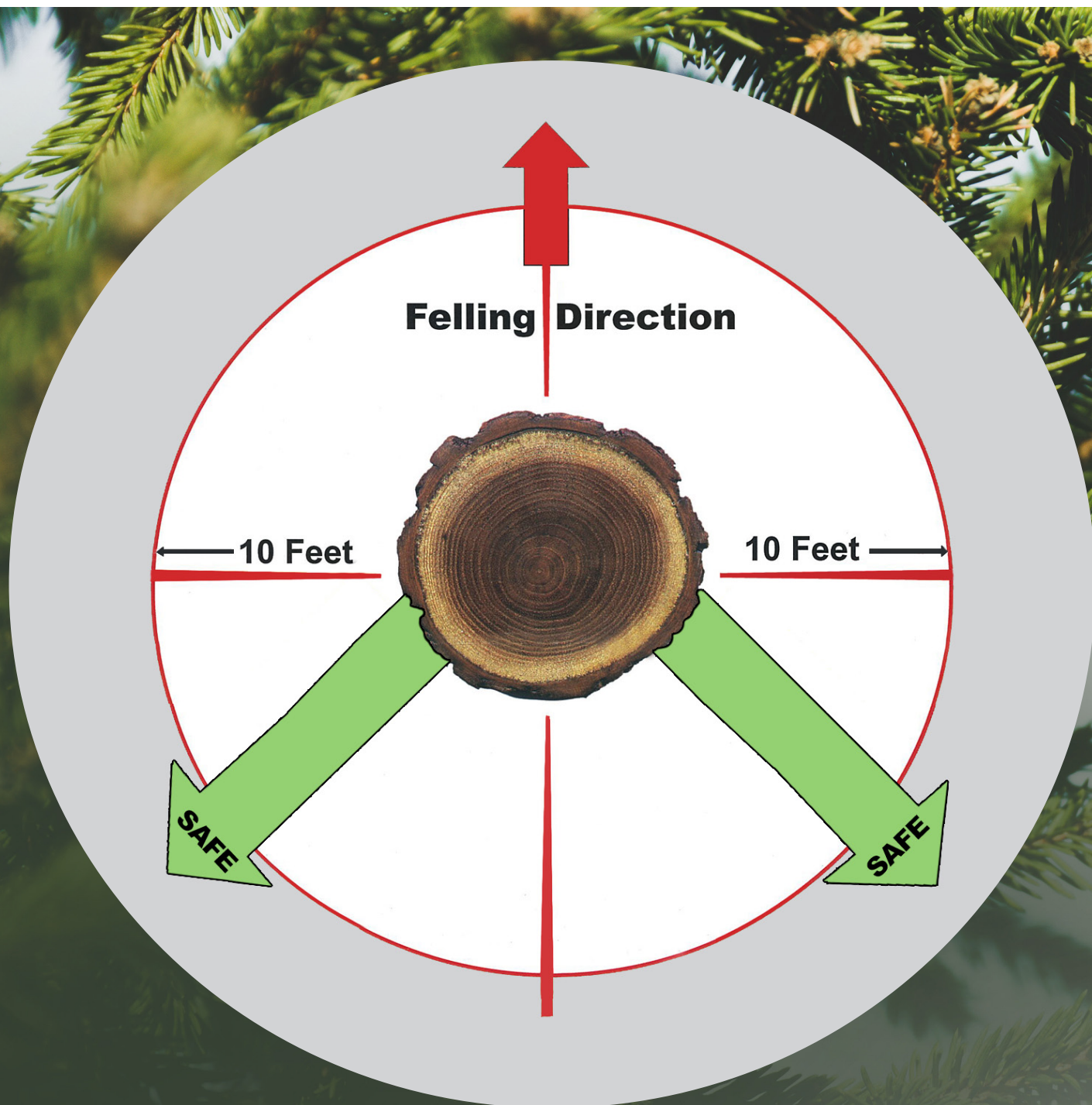

# Most **SERIOUS FALLING INJURIES** happen **within 10 feet** of the **STUMP**



Escape routes must be well brushed out before falling begins and should be at a

**45 degree angle**

preferably to the **high or safe side** of the stump.

## 26.24 Responsibility for falling and bucking

(7) When a tree starts to fall, the faller and any other worker present must move quickly to a predetermined safe position, at least 3m (10ft) away from the base of the tree where possible, and take cover if available.
