#### **Description :**

- R = recognize the risk
- A = assess the situation
- D = develop a safe solution
- A = act safely to fix the problem
- R = report and record the upset condition

# **Contributing Factors:**

Assess the Situation. Ask yourself "what could go wrong". The next 5 questions in the 10 step assessment are:

6. Body Position - While travelling to work - wear you seatbelt!7. PPE - What personal protective equipment is required for your task?

8. Lockout - when the the crew transport has a flat tire is it properly locked - blocked - chocked while changing the tire?9. Trained - Is the driver of the crew transport licensed, trained , alert and focused on the job?

10. Help - If you are unsure about how to do a task - just ask!



## **Recommended Preventative Actions:**

Getting to work and getting back is one of the most dangerous parts of a silviculture workers job. Long drives, busy roads and fatigued drivers are all factors that contribute to incidents during worker transport. Everyone wants to arrive alive - report unsafe conditions to your supervisor.

## **Discussions / Follow-up Actions:**

Does the crew know the safe work procedures for changing a flat tire? Do you have alternate drivers for your vehicles?What is your companies method for reporting unsafe conditions? (use the back of the sheet if necessary to record the discussion)
