DESCRIPTION OF EVENT

Trespasser and Drug Paraphernalia

Reposted: April 30, 2020

Mill personnel were following up on a report of trespassers on the mill property and discovered a camp/shelter. The RCMP was called and the campsite was inspected for stolen property and illegal substances.

When the inspection was complete, mill personnel were given permission to cleanup the campsite and found a tent, bicycles, garbage and two used syringes.

SUGGESTED ACTIONS

- During the pre-shift, crew safety talk, review the requirement to report all trespassers to supervisors immediately.
- Instruct all supervisors to call the police if a trespasser is discovered.
- Do not approach trespassers. Ensuring the safety of crew and the trespasser is a priority. Stop all mobile equipment and/or machinery as needed.
- Ensure any intervention and clean-up involves a thorough pre-work hazard assessment including safe handling & safe disposal of items found.



MOST IMPORTANT TAKE AWAY

Campsites located on the mill sites have the potential for sharps and biological hazards.

Perform a pre-work hazard that includes blood borne pathogen safe work procedures.
