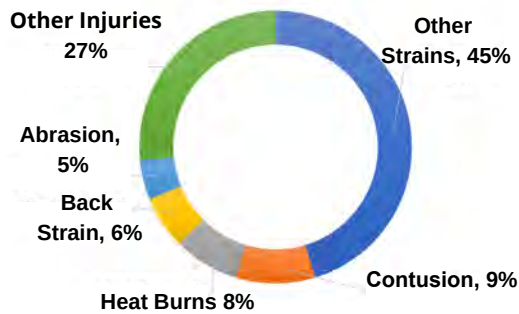

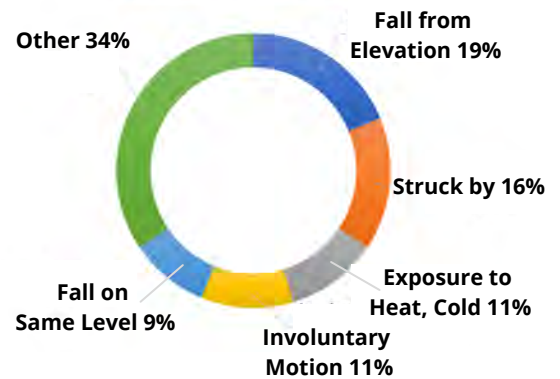

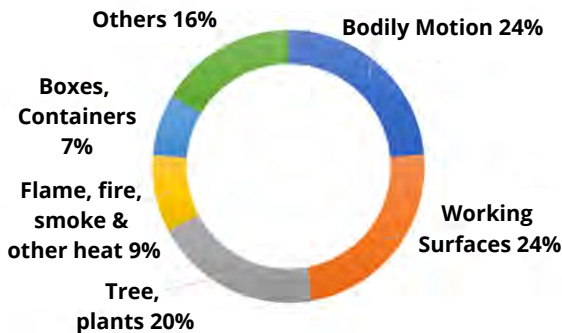
#### Nature of Injury



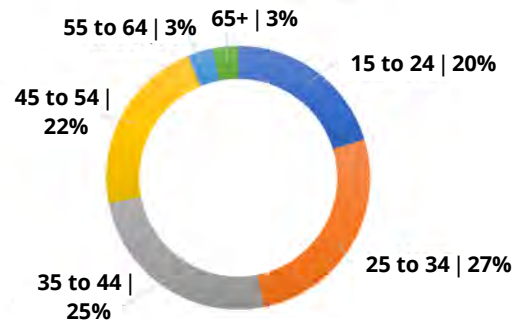
#### Mechanism of Injury

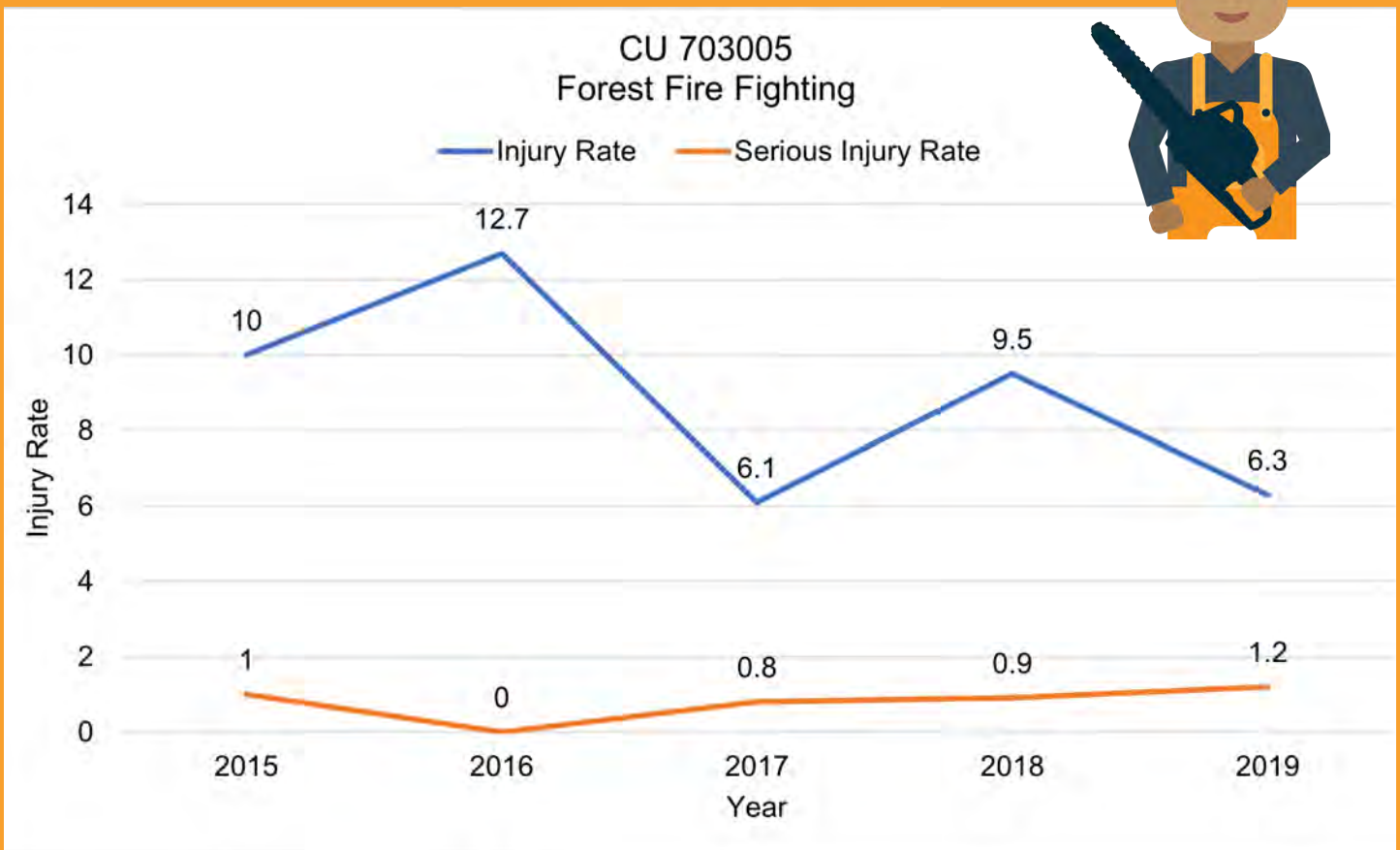
