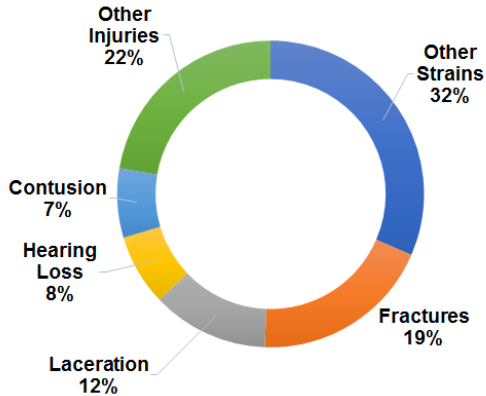

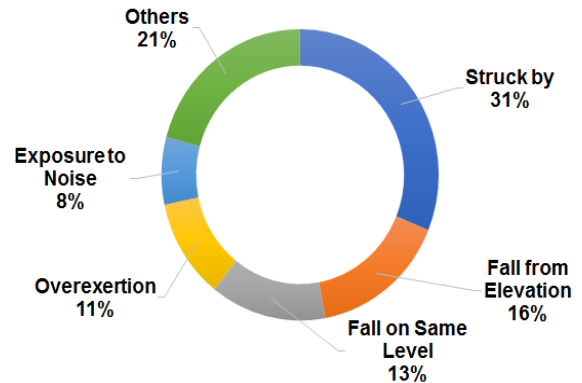

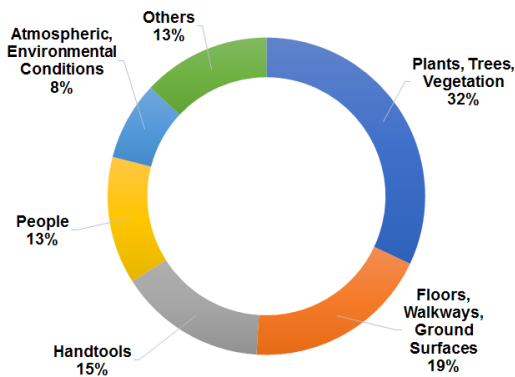
Nature of Injury



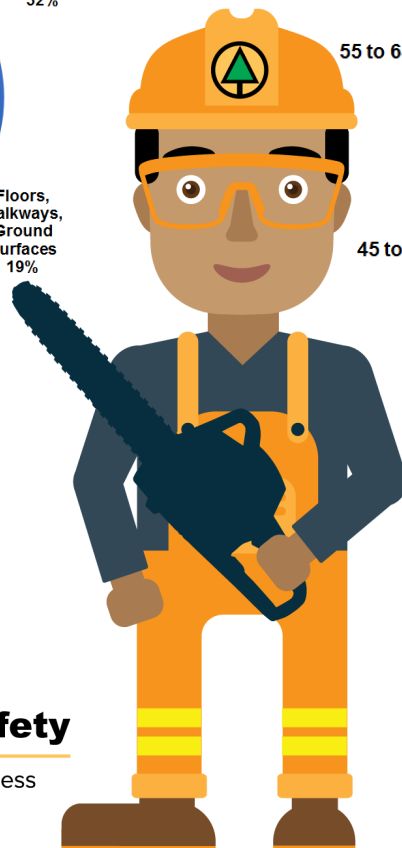
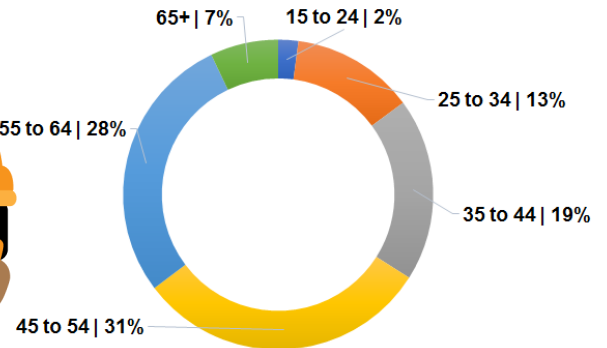
Mechanism of Injury

- 21% are long-recovery strains and sprains

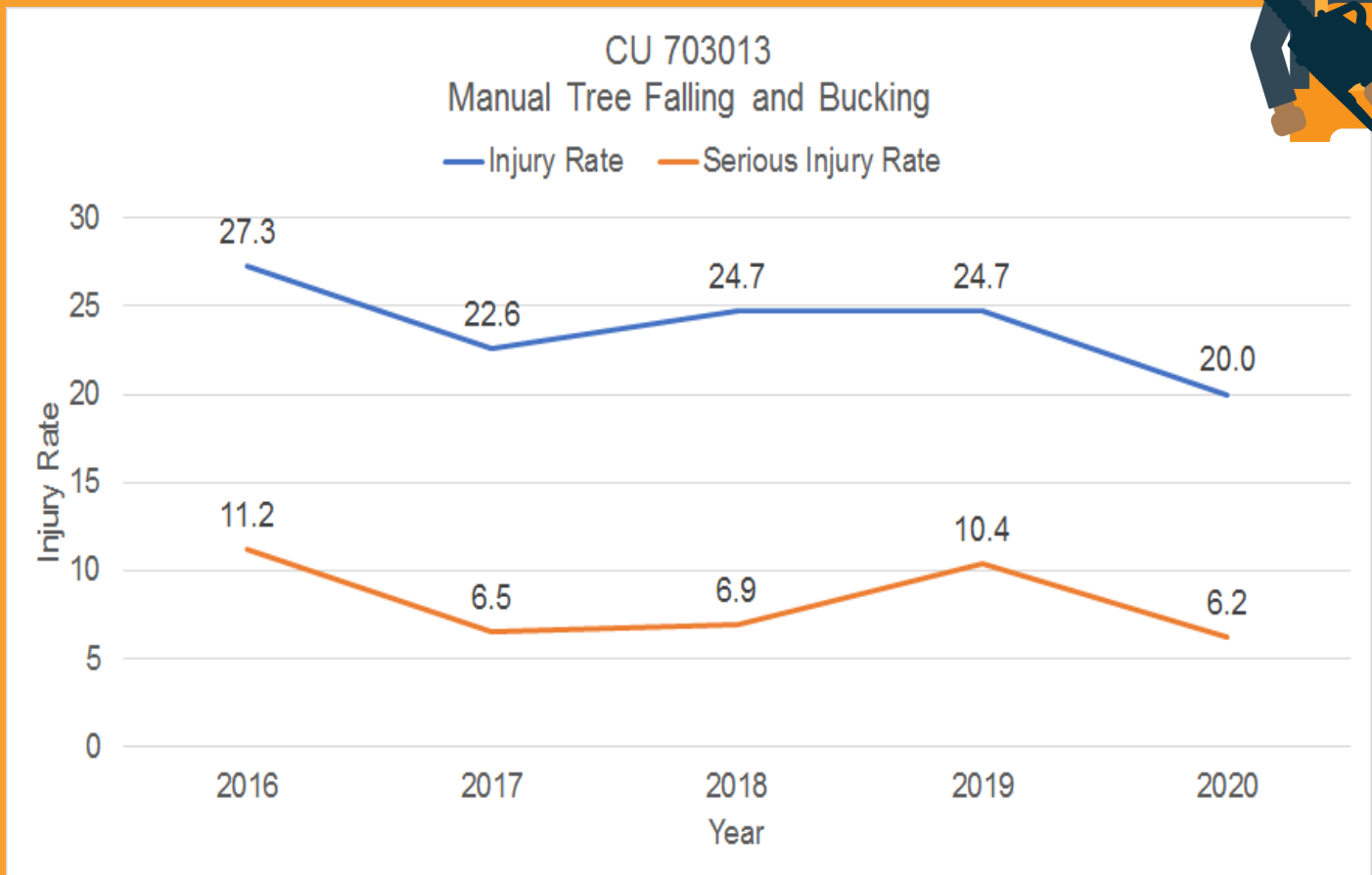
