MOBILE EQUIPMENT

Always follow the manufacturers recommendations

Areas to clean inside your cab

- Steering Wheel
- Control buttons, toggles and levers
- Seatbelt
- Hand brakes
- Mirrors



ALSO CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING

- Door handles (inside and out)
- Seats
- HMI screens
(use only approved cleaning solutions)
- VHF radio controls
- Windows
- Crew Pick-up (high touch areas)

HOW TO CLEAN

- Wear gloves when cleaning
- Do not pour liquid on any part of a machine
- Spray disinfecting solution onto a cleaning cloth
- Wipe down high touch areas
- Do not mix chemicals
- Discard cloth when cleanup is complete or when it becomes soiled.
