Forest Industry Reporting System

BCFSC FIRS App – Quick Add version now available

The BCFSC FIRS App or Forest Industry Reporting System is a FREE resource available to all BCFSC Members.

Its purpose is to assist supervisors in managing due diligence paperwork, monitor worker training and certifications, and help manage SAFE Companies audit submissions using a measurable tracking system.

The first stage of the BCFSC FIRS App is a lite version of the App called **Quick Add**. This version is now complete and is live and ready to use. **Quick Add** allows companies to submit and track incident reporting by submitting answers to five simple questions and uploading supporting photos into the record.

Download the FIRS App through the App store for Android and iOS devices. You will require a FIRS account to use the App. Email your registration request to FIRS@bcforestsafe.org.
