DESCRIPTION OF EVENT

Kiln Fan Deck Fall Hazard

A worker was walking on the kiln's #2 fan deck, on the radiator side, checking fan hubs and blades.

They reached for a magnetic tool that a previous worker had left on deck when the floor gave way beneath their right foot.

The worker's foot fell through the hole 14 inches catching on a pipe.

The piece of flooring fell but got hung up on some fire protection pipes.



SUGGESTED ACTIONS

- Inspect all kilns as per the <u>"Kiln Inspection Checklist"</u> and then annually thereafter.
- 2. Update the Computer Maintenance system to include inspecting flooring to monthly inspection (or by some other means to track this activity). <u>Review Dry Kiln Preventative</u> <u>Maintenance.</u>
- 3. The Kiln should be full of wood to break the fall of workers if the floor gives way.
