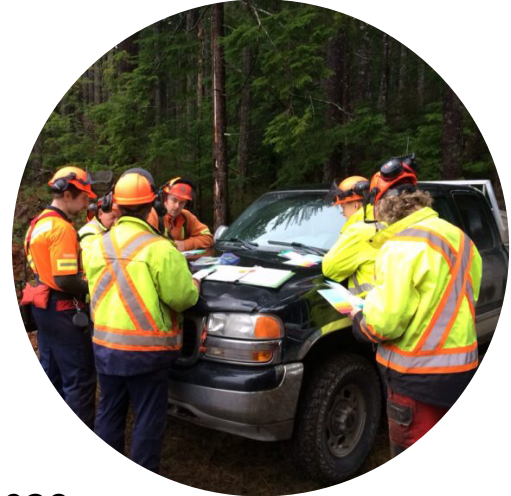

Support for BC Forestry Workers: Training and Skills Development Funding

A variety of funding programs are available in BC to support forestry worker training and skills development. Eligible workers, employers and companies may be able to access grants and other financial assistance to support training initiatives.



Current Funding Opportunities

Forestry Training Fund: Available as of July 31, 2026

A \$6.9 million Forestry Training Fund is available to eligible forestry employers in British Columbia, including community forests. The program provides funding to support workforce training and skills development across the sector.

BC Employer Training Grant

The BC Employer Training Grant may provide partial reimbursement of eligible training costs for employers seeking to enhance the skills and capabilities of their workforce.
